

PREVENTING WORLD TERRORISM THROUGH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A DIPLOMATIC BODY

*The General Assembly,*

*Realizing* the pressing need to eradicate all forms of international terrorism,

*Alarmed* by nations who are unable to take preventative measures against terrorism in their own nations,

*Reaffirming* the existing commitments made by nations to foster international security,

*Stressing* the importance of a unified approach to preventing terrorism,

1. Deplores the existence of international terrorism in countries across the world;
2. Urges countries to recognize the need for an international coalition to help prevent terrorism in individual states;
3. Suggests to the General Assembly the implementation of an UN diplomatic body, as a sub-committee of the CTC, that will be summoned by individual states, in order to assess the terrorist threat in their country and provide recommendations for solutions of said issues;
4. Recommends that the diplomatic body report to this committee on bi-annual basis in order to assess the progress of prevention within states that have expressed their desire to eliminate terrorism;
5. Calls upon all states to provide resources, be they natural, financial, or other, in order to further aid countries who wish to implement recommendations made by the previously-stated body, in regards to eliminating terrorism;
6. Further encourages the organisation to establish a forum on neutral ground with non-state actors with political aims as well as governments to emphasize that violent means being used by terrorist groups to promote their views are reprehensible and unacceptable. This would promote diplomatic communication between non-state actors with political aims and governments.
