HIV/AIDS AND THE ISSUE OF FUNDING

Realizing the lack of funds available in the fight against HIV/AIDS,

Emphasizing the paramount importance of more monetary aid for the Global Fund for HIV/AIDS to prevent the further spread of HIV/AIDS,

Affirming previous donations and contributions of various countries, private, organizations and international organizations,

Realizing that education research methods and overall eradication cannot be effective without more funding,

Recognizing that poverty is a key factor in the increase in HIV/AIDS virus,

Reassuring that the UNAIDS holds the countries and NGOs accountable for money that they receive,

- 1. <u>Requests</u> that countries be held accountable to the financial pledges made to the Global Fund administered by UNAIDS, in order to ensure that the monetary needs of the fund are met;
- 2. <u>Further requests</u> that private organizations and multinational corporations be fully involved in the eradication of HIV/AIDS in the countries they are working in, through specific donations to the governments and local NGOs for the express purpose of fighting HIV/AIDS.
