

A Resolution Regarding Disarmament and Development

The General Assembly,

Having considered the report of the European Union's Protocol in relation to the limitations of armament expenditure and percentage of GDP to be spent on arms as well as the UNDP Development Report of 2003.

1. *Reaffirms* the right of all states to ensure the security of its citizens and guarantee its territorial integrity;
2. *Recognizes* the role of armed conflict in impeding development;
3. *Requests* that all member states evaluate the percentage of their GNP spent on arms acquisitions, in the spirit of Article 26 of the UN Charter;
4. *Reaffirms* the United Nations Millennium Declaration and request that all members states adhere to their millennium development commitments of 0.7% of their GDP as declared in the 11th clause of the Millennium Summit;
5. *Requests* the issue of Disarmament and Development and the resolutions of this committee be taken into consideration of the Security Council.
