Security Council Reform

The General Assembly,

Recognizing that the majority of members view the use of veto power on Security Council as an anachronistic, discriminatory, undemocratic instrument,

Recognizing the United Nations as a democratic organization,

Recognizing the changes in the world since the creation of the United Nations,

1. Strongly recommends that 2 vetoes will be required (instead of one) to block any Security Council motions, actions, or resolutions.
