INTERNATIONAL MIGRATION RIGHTS

The Economic and Social Council,

Favouring an approach aimed at improving the quality of life of migrants and their families, in accordance with human rights, and especially those of minority groups,

In accordance with Article 1 and 14(1) of the *Universal Declaration of Human Rights,*

Reaffirming that all individuals have a right to earn an adequate income in humane working conditions, regardless of race, gender, religion, ethnicity or country of origin,

Concerned with the loss of human resources as a result of migration and the negative effects of mass migration on families and communities in home and host countries,

Recognizing the seriousness of the situation of refugees as well as that of migrants,

Recognizing that since most migration occurs regionally, a cooperative approach is required,

1. Calls for the establishment of regional, peer-review mechanisms through which home and host countries can monitor the progress of migration and implementation of programs to improve the lives of migrant and refugee populations;
2. Recommends that the above establishment be under the auspices of the United Nations Educational Scientific and Cultural Organization in order to encourage transparency and efficiency;
3. Suggests that host countries' provision of educational and developmental services to the migrants and refugees accommodating their cultural identities be monitored;
4. Requests that home countries be monitored in order to ensure the implementation of programs to decrease mass migration, such as education, improving minority rights and community development programs;
5. Welcomes international financial participation in this endeavour.
